The Michelin Corporate Foundation signs a sponsorship agreement with Aviation Sans Frontières

The Michelin Corporate Foundation engaged with Aviation Sans Frontières ("ASF") has agreed to a two year partnership along with a sponsorship agreement in the event of a serious health crisis to support its humanitarian missions.

Since its inception, Aviation Sans Frontières has been developing two crucial activities aimed at integrating isolated and destitute populations: 1) to escort sick children; and 2) medical messaging. Through the help of numerous NGOs, "ASF" escorts more than 600 sick children suffering from serious pathologies to European hospitals every year. The escorted children can thus benefit from surgical interventions that are impossible to perform in their country of origin. The children are thus treated and brought back to their families cured.

The association is also working to establish a medical messaging system, which will allow the supply of essential health products, to help those in the most vulnerable areas. Each year, nearly 8,000 medical parcels are sent to 26 needy countries.

In line with its values of respect and solidarity, Philippe Legrez, Managing Director of the Michelin Corporate Foundation, declared: "The Michelin Group and Aviation Sans Frontières share the same values. The issues of mobility and solidarity-based transport are at the heart of the Foundation's and Michelin Group's activities. We are delighted to be able to support Aviation Sans Frontières through this sponsorship agreement."
